



Top Highway Safety Tips

Farmers

1. Make sure lights are legal and working
2. Use hazard lights and slow moving vehicle emblems
3. Take caution while driving machinery across or onto a main highway
4. Provide a follow car with flashing lights
5. Pay attention to attachments
6. If traffic backs up, pull over
7. Limit movements of equipment during evening or peak traffic hours

Top Highway Safety Tips

Drivers

1. Slow down when you see farm equipment
2. Watch for hand signals and turn signals
3. Do not speed past farm machinery
4. Look out for the triangular slow moving vehicle sign
5. Don't pull out in front of a slow moving vehicle
6. Do not expect equipment to run partly on shoulders
7. Share the road
